In recognition of Girl Scout Week

Whereas, on behalf of the citizens of the City of Cleveland, I am honored to offer this Proclamation designating the week of March 6 to March 12, 2011, as Girl Scout Week in the City of Cleveland; and

Whereas, Girl Scouts of North East Ohio (GSNEO) began a partnership ten years ago with Cuyahoga Metropolitan Housing Authority (CMHA) to deliver Girl Scout programming to girls in public housing estates in Cleveland. Because of the organization's commitment to providing quality leadership programming and educational opportunities to underserved populations, GSNEO has nurtured and grown this program over the past decade; and

Whereas, in 2010, GSNEO served nearly 300 girls ages 5-17 in all eight CMHA housing estates. This program is currently delivered by both trained volunteers and one full-time staff member, Kareemah Rose, who has become a welcome face in the neighborhoods over the years; and

Whereas, GSNEO delivers leadership development programming to participants in a variety of focus areas, including financial literacy, STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math), environmental awareness, the arts and healthy living, and community service, their primary focus area.

Now therefore, I, Frank G. Jackson, the 56th Mayor of the City of Cleveland, do hereby offer this Proclamation designating the week of March 6 to March 12, 2011, Girl Scout Week in the City of Cleveland.
