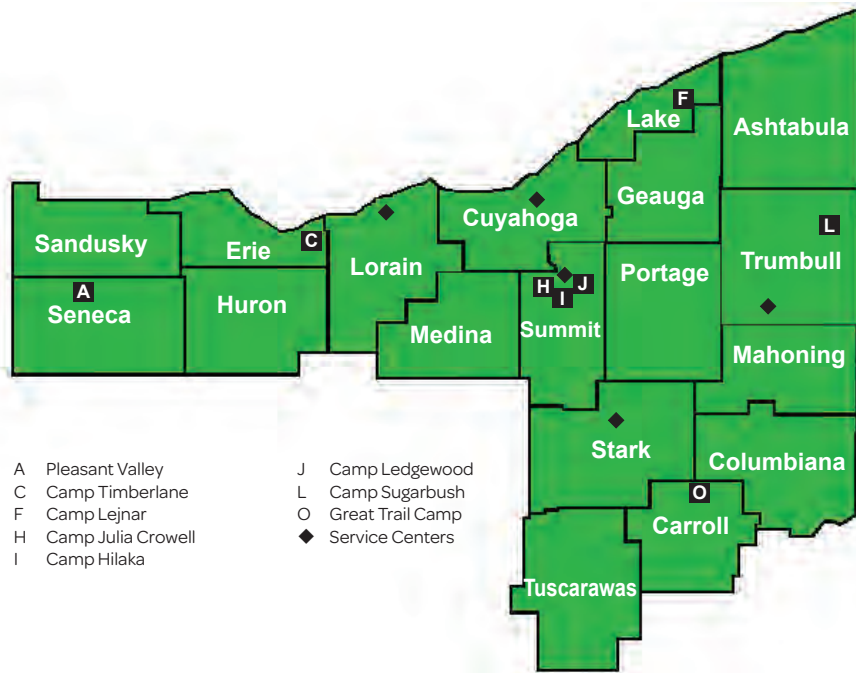

ABOUT US

Girl Scouts of North East Ohio (GSNEO) serves 40,000 girls and 14,000 adults in an 18-county region.

Girl Scouts is the preeminent leadership development organization for girls, with 3.6 million girl and adult members worldwide. The Girl Scout Leadership Experience is what makes Girl Scouting unique. Leadership programs give girls the opportunity to travel the world, learn 21st Century business skills and become the next generation of community leaders.

JURISDICTION

GSNEO serves girls and adult volunteers in Ashtabula, Carroll, Columbiana, Cuyahoga, Erie, Geauga, Huron, Lake, Lorain, Mahoning, Medina, Portage, Sandusky, Seneca, Stark, Summit, Trumbull and Tuscarawas Counties.

MEMBERSHIP

Membership is extended to all girls ages 5-17 and all adults ages 18 and older regardless of race, color, ethnicity, creed, national origin, socio-economic status, sex or disability who accept the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

MISSION

Girl Scouting builds girls of Courage, Confidence, and Character, who make the world a better place.

HISTORY

Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) was founded on March 12, 1912 by Juliette Gordon Low.

GOVERNANCE

Girl Scouts of North East Ohio is governed by a volunteer board whose guidance ensures Girl Scouting is available for all girls who want to participate, now and in the future.

**SERVICES**

- Leadership and personal development training for girls and adult volunteers
- Girl-led programs that promote positive self-image, ethical conduct and embrace diversity
- Six program focus areas which provide girls with an understanding of the world around them  
They are: *Science Technology Engineering and Math (STEM), Community Engagement, Healthy Living, Financial Literacy, the Arts, and Environmental Awareness*
- Multiple pathways to participate in Girl Scout programming via troop, special events, short-term programs, camp, travel and Internet-based modules.

**PROGRAM**

Girl Scouting is unique in that it is the only girl organization that teaches leadership development. The three keys to leadership form the basis of all Girl Scout programs. They are:

- **Discover:** Girl Scouts explore their world, envisioning and preparing for a positive future.
- **Connect:** Girl Scouts understand and care about the needs of others.
- **Take Action:** Girl Scouts act to make the world a better place.

**FEES**

Individual membership dues (\$12), paid annually by girls and adults, go directly to GSUSA. They provide activity insurance, support services and program material. Financial assistance is available for those who qualify.

**FUNDING**

On an average it costs \$250 per girl, to provide one year of Girl Scouting. GSNEO depends on income generated from both its membership and the community to facilitate council-wide programs and events; provide adult recruitment and training; enhance outreach opportunities and maintain the council's service centers and camp/environmental education facilities.

Anyone may contribute to Girl Scouts. Special giving opportunities are available to individuals through planned giving, Tribute Funds or Memorial Gifts. Income is also generated by a variety of sources including United Way, corporate sponsorships, grants, program fees and two annual product sales campaigns.
