- **Consider whether you want to share the nomination with the nominee at any point.** Some individuals who nominate may choose to involve the nominee in the writing process, while others keep it a secret. Both methods of nominations are acceptable.
- **Sharing Media:** If you choose to share articles, videos, websites, etc. illustrating the nominee's accomplishments, please know we will be removing names from the pieces, as well as summarizing the information to maintain anonymity.
