Thank you for taking the time to nominate a Leader of Tomorrow! This PDF is provided as a reference to help you review the nomination questions and prepare your responses before submitting your nomination via the Microsoft Form.

Below are some tips to assist you as you begin writing your nomination:

- **Assume that the submitted nomination is the only information used to decide the honorees.** Decisions are based on the written information provided, reviewed by our selection committee anonymously, with the name of the nominee removed. A detailed response will be able to provide our selection committee with a clear picture as to why your nominee should be selected.
- **Consider whether you want to share the nomination with the nominee at any point.** Some individuals who nominate may choose to involve the nominee in the writing process, while others keep it a secret. Both methods of nominations are acceptable.
- **Reflect on the values of Girl Scouting.** As you complete the nomination, consider how the nominee exemplifies the Girl Scout Mission, Law, and Promise through their actions, leadership, service, and character. Be sure to include specific examples whenever possible.

Girl Scouting builds girls of courage, confidence, and character, who make the world a better place.

Girl Scout Law

Girl Scout Promise

2. Achievements Beyond Girl Scouts

Feel free to provide a detailed account, including accomplishments and challenges overcome.
