

Camp Ledgewood Letterboxing

There are 8 Letterboxes placed on the camp property: be prepared to trek all over camp to find them all! Each contains a unique rubbing plate.

To find these letterboxes you will need to bring some supplies: a notebook to collect the rubbings in and something to make the rubbings, pencil and crayon work the best.

Unlike geocaching, letterboxing has clues to follow. Each clue will lead you to a different letterbox. Be sure to bring a camp map to help with the clues. Try your best to use the clues to find the boxes and only use the solutions when needed. Always place the rubbing plate back in the box for the next letterboxers to find!

1. From the Parking Lot, you are sure to be close. Head towards our founder's lodge, say hello. Then head out on the trail to Lemen. Be sure not to go too far. For this box lays upon the home of trolls.
2. From the parking lot you've got a hike. Head towards the Lake that looms. Find what you need to make a campfire and here you will find a box just for you!
3. Starting at Chickadee head towards the boats. Say hi the the lake and keep going. Around you shall go to a shelter with a sponsor. Check the posts for what you seek.
4. Near Lake Loomis then up a small hill. The field is great for games and the pavilion provides an excellent hiding space for this box.
5. Head towards the pool and the cabin where you can hang out in a hammock. From here you will want to hit the trail. The box you seek will be where you must choose between Cricket and Glacier!
6. To find this box, it is a nature shower that you seek. Head towards Chestnut Burr then down the path.
7. A special place for the birds is where you will find this box. This diner provides the opportunity to hand feed the Chickadees! The box you seek is right before you enter.
8. Especially made for Brownies this land is for all to play and build. Find the Brownie elf and look behind her to find the home of this box.
