

Camp Sugarbush Letterboxing

There are 8 Letterboxes placed on the camp property: be prepared to trek all over camp to find them all! Each contains a unique rubbing plate.

To find these letterboxes you will need to bring some supplies: a notebook to collect the rubbings in and something to make the rubbings, pencil and crayon work the best.

Unlike geocaching, letterboxing has clues to follow. Each clue will lead you to a different letterbox. Be sure to bring a camp map to help with the clues. Try your best to use the clues to find the boxes and only use the solutions when needed. Always place the rubbing plate back in the box for the next letterboxers to find!

1. Head to a place to explore nature near the Green Cathedral. You will find the box outside of this building. Tucked in, well actually, on a “nook.”
2. This is a place where teams are built. Head from main camp to the low ropes course. Here you will find some stairs that this box calls home.
3. Hit the trails from the main parking lot. Head out past the pool down the road to a point where you must make a choice Target Sports or Low Ropes. This box couldn’t decide so it stayed put right here!
4. To find this box you must trek to the Target sprots range. Here you will look for an old west saloon. There at the bottom is this box’s home.
5. Before you even arrive at the parking lot this box has already greeted you. Head to the front of camp property, maybe snap a picture with the Camp Sugarbush sign. Now facing camp, you will see a sign that tells you where things are located. Check that sign out!
6. Girls Grow strong here at Camp Sugarbush. Close to the parking lot we proclaim it to the world!
7. This is a great place to have lunch on a sunny day. Head from the parking lot towards the Lodge but don’t go in check out the Pavilion instead.
8. Take a Hike! Head towards the Upper Creek Trail (Pink). Be sure to put on your bug spray and check the trailhead for what you seek!
