

## Camp Timberlane Letterboxing

There are 8 Letterboxes placed on the camp property: be prepared to trek all over camp to find them all! Each contains a unique rubbing plate.

To find these letterboxes you will need to bring some supplies: a notebook to collect the rubbings in and something to make the rubbings, pencil and crayon work the best.

Unlike geocaching, letterboxing has clues to follow. Each clue will lead you to a different letterbox. Be sure to bring a camp map to help with the clues. Try your best to use the clues to find the boxes and only use the solutions when needed. Always place the rubbing plate back in the box for the next letterboxers to find!

1. Stop! As you head down the road towards Nar, this box found it's home someplace easy to spy.
2. Leave from the Welcome Center, you will take a hike down around the lake and towards the place that Nature can be studied. This Center tells all about Ohio wildlife. Check outside this building for the box you seek.
3. Pee Yew! This box is some place that smells bad. Find this box by heading towards Stocker Lodge. When you reach Stocker Lodge check outside for some place stinky to find the box.
4. It's time to hit the trails to find this box. Head out towards Tall Timbers. Be sure to take the trail! Find what you seek between Tall Timbers and Cherry Hill where a troll may sleep.
5. This box isn't too far. To find it go to the oldest cabin at camp and then find the Latrine. Search all around for what you seek.
6. Anchors away! Take a hike around the lake to find this box as far away from the dock as you can get. This box is hanging out with a throw ring.
7. The building at the Edge of the Water is where you want to head. This box is where first aid might be given. Head around back and check all the porches.
8. Welcome to Camp! This box is hanging out near the Welcome Center. Head to a place to light a fire and there will be what you desire.
