Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How are housing assignments determined?

A: Cadettes will choose their housing location during the online registration process. Cadettes will be picking their sleeping unit type. Housing details will be shared during check-in. This is not a troop event, and troops will not be assigned to stay in the same cabin. Buddy requests will be accepted.

Q: Can my child substitute program activities?

A: No substitutions can be made to the program activities. Each track has been arranged to allow girls a diverse range of activities.

Q: What meals are included?

A: Meals for Saturday and Sunday are included in the price of registration. Specifically, there will be breakfast, lunch, dinner on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday. On both Friday and Saturday evenings, a snack will be provided. Throughout the weekend, grab and go snacks will be available in the dining hall.

Q: How do I relay dietary restrictions and other special accommodations?

A: Special accommodations and dietary restrictions can be noted during online registration. If you would like to have a conversation about your camper's needs, please reach out to Customer Care that will put you in touch with the camp team.

Q: Can my child attend with a buddy?

A: Yes, your child may choose a buddy to attend with. This will be done through registration by listing them as buddy. Cadette Summit is designed for girls from all over the GSNEO footprint to get together for the weekend and make new friends. This is NOT a troop event.

Q: When does registration open?

A: Registration opens Saturday March 15,2025 at 6 AM.

Q: How are the girls supervised?

A: Girls are supervised by a team of adult volunteers. All volunteers are registered Girl Scouts with an active background check on file. As we want the girls to be more independent adult volunteers who have Cadettes attending either their own child or troop members will be assigned to a different location than their Cadette(s).

Q: Who do I contact in case of an Emergency?

A: In case of an emergency, please call Camp Ledgewood at 330-650-4743. This will connect you directly to camp staff.

Q: What if my child wants to come home early?

A: If your Cadette would like to leave early, you will need to contact a member of camp staff by calling Camp Ledgewood at 330-650-4743. This ensures that call children are accounted for all weekend.

Q: Can my child bring her cell phone?

A: Like any other expensive or sentimental item, phones are highly discouraged at camp. Camp is an unpredictable outdoor environment; Cadettes should only bring items that are okay to get muddy or lost. Leaving phones at home will also allow your Cadette to focus on the programming and be "in the moment" while at camp. Charging facilities will not be available at camp.

If your Cadette does decide to bring her phone and contacts you to ask for forgotten items or to leave early, caregivers MUST contact the camp staff onsite. Please call Camp Ledgewood at 330-650-4743. For safety reasons, no persons will be allowed on camp property without the prior approval of the camp staff.
