

I had the opportunity to travel to Savannah, Georgia with my family recently where we visited the Juliette Gordon Low Birthplace. This is where Juliette Low, the creator of Girl Scouts, was raised. We were able to tour her luxurious house where her sculptures, paintings, books, and souvenirs from her world travels are displayed. It was quite inspiring to be immersed in her childhood home and learn about her upbringing that motivated Juliette to ignore social norms and set a strong example for young girls in her community, which eventually became an international organization. Another member of the tour group was from England, and she told us about her involvement in Girl Guides, which is England's equivalent to Girl Scouts. Juliette's strong legacy was evident not only in what was displayed in her childhood home, but also to how her example has impacted women and girls all over the world to this day!
