Field Trips Programs at the DreamLab

In a space designed to inspire, students will rotate through 3 fun stations where they can explore technology, dream about their futures, learn about their strengths and play at our basecamp!

The Jane Norton Girl Scout DreamLab in Sheffield Village can accommodate one class (up to 32) K-3 students at a time. Field Trips at the DreamLab typically last from 10am-12pm or 12pm-2pm.



SOCIAL EMOTIONAL LEARNING

At the SEL station students will learn about what makes us each unique and special. Students will engage with SEL as they look inward to determine their core values and create a tangible representation of their strengths and creativity.



HANDS-ON TECHNOLOGY

In the STEM Cafe students will explore technology and coding as they code robots, navigate mazes, create with 3D pens and more. Students of all ages and ability levels will think like an engineer as they solve problems with technology!



PLAY AT BASECAMP

The DreamLab brings the camp world inside for all kids! Climb on our rotating rock wall, make a pretend smore on our camp fire, learn a new skill at our knot-tying station, or play with some critters in our tent!



Important Information

To avoid a cancellation fee, all cancellations must be made at least two calendar weeks before the trip. All students should wear closed toed shoes and tie back long hair on the experience. The DreamLab requires at least 1 adult chaperone for every 15 students. There is no kitchen at the DreamLab. If the school wishes to bring snacks they may. We ask that students have a photo waiver signed that will be sent to the teacher ahead of time.
