- Lead the Task Force and recruit its members
- Help **identify funding** sources and **support fundraising efforts** for programming and Highest Awards projects
- Gain high-level knowledge and understanding of the **Changemakers** structure, goals, and performance
- Serve as a **community ambassador** and identify people, organizations, and community spaces with available resources, as well as opportunities for professional development
- Thoughtfully consider all information presented, maintain confidentiality, respectfully discuss with other members of the committee, and make best **recommendations** that will successfully guide the initiative

### Great work starts with clear expectations.

- **Follow the Rules:** Comply with GSUSA Policies, Standards and Guidelines, Volunteer Essentials, Safety Activity Checkpoints, GSNEO Bylaws, and GSNEO Volunteer Policies.
- **Communication:** Volunteers in this role need to be able to send and receive messages through email.
- **Term:** One Year. This role is in support of a pilot program. Renewal is based on the viability of Changemakers.
- **Time Expectations:** There will be quarterly Task Force meetings. Members will also be expected to advocate for the program outside of the structured meetings.
