Here are some of the awesome things you'll do as a Properties Committee Member:

- Assist in creating, reviewing, vetting and approving the **Master Plan**
- Provide **fiscal oversight** and **guidance to projects, their budgets and timelines**
- Participate in **fundraising and outreach as needed**
- Advocate for projects at the local, state and federal level as needed
- Review the annual capital budget and proposed projects
- Advise the staff on applicable innovation in construct , architectural, maintenance or other related fields that would enhance the operations of any GSNEO property.
- Contribute to problem solving on property issues elevated by staff, volunteers or community members
- **Communicate and promote** the GSNEO mission and programs to the community

Great work starts with clear expectations.

- **Follow the Rules:** Comply with GSUSA Policies, Standards and Guidelines, Volunteer Essentials, Safety Activity Checkpoints, GSNEO Bylaws, and GSNEO Volunteer Policies.
- **Communication:** Volunteers in this role need to be able to send and receive messages through email.
- **Renewal:** This role is reviewed every year and can be renewed if both the volunteer and Board agree.
- **Time Expectations:** Property Committee Meetings are held quarterly.
