As the Strategic Initiative Committee Chair, you'll get support from the GSNEO Chief Executive Officer. Additional support will be provided by the volunteers and staff serving on the committee, as well as any GSNEO staff as needed to inform the process.

As the Strategic Initiative Committee Chair, you will:

- Lead the Committee and help recruit its members
- Gain high-level knowledge and understanding of the Girl Scout Leadership Experience program and training
- Serve as a community ambassador and identify people and organizations with available resources
- Thoughtfully consider all information presented, maintain confidentiality, respectfully discuss with other members of the committee, and make best recommendations for initiatives that will successfully guide the leadership of GSNEO
- Identify new and innovative business techniques, organizational or professional expertise, or technology
- Assess GSNEO's impact on the community through review of high-level program analyses including: outcome measurement, programs, customer surveys, membership recruitment and retention, advertising, and fund development
- Consider making a personally significant contribution to GSNEO

Qualifications and Core Competencies.

- Interest in supporting the Girl Scout Mission and the Girl Scout Leadership Experience
- Expertise in marketing, non-profit best practices, operations, fundraising, advertising, communication, research and program evaluation, law, sales, programming, finance, human resources, analytics, volunteer recruitment and management, or other relative disciplines

 - Enhanced Financial Stability – Including Growing Revenue and Enterprise Risk Management
 - Talent and Culture
