

Courteous Camper

The courteous camper recognition will begin on October 1, 2022. This new recognition will be given by property managers, registration staff and volunteer camp coaches to troops who earn a score of 100% on their checkout sheet and the requirements listed below. Troops and groups that stay a minimum of one night are eligible for the recognition. Troops/Groups participating in a Service Unit campout are also eligible, but the Service Unit as a group would not be. Troops that are sharing a site, should work together to achieve their score of 100%. Property managers, Registration staff and volunteer camp coaches will make the final decisions.

All troops that achieve the Courteous Camper will be recognized in the CEO Newsletter and will be placed into a drawing for a \$100 discount on a future camping weekend (18-month expiration). The drawings will be held quarterly, at the end of each quarter and include only those troops who received the Courteous Camper recognition during the quarter, one drawing per camp. The winning troop will receive their discount notification via email.

Your troop can receive an additional courteous camper entry for your courtesy during the camp reservation process. To qualify for your pre-camp entry, your troop must have:

- Submitted your full roster no later than 30 days prior to your campout.
 - Your roster must include the names of your Outdoor Essentials and First Aid/CPR/AED certified volunteers (and proof of their certifications, if we have not previously confirmed to you that their certifications are on file).
- Made no changes to the campout roster after your Final Roster/Site Permit was issued (except in the case of an emergency).
- Provided timely responses (within 2 business days) to GSNEO staff regarding your reservation if we reached out to you regarding questions or concerns.

It's that simple!

To qualify for the SECOND entry into the drawing troops must meet the following requirements while at camp:

- Troops must follow all [SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR VISITING CAMP](#) and use of site as listed in the Camp Compass and on gsneo.org
- Troops are following [Safety Activity Checkpoints](#) related to Camping, This includes girl adult rations & having a first aid kit.
- No policy violations during the campout.
- Turn in site permit upon arrival, with an updated roster.
- Fire and stoves are attended at all times while lit or in use.
- Luggage carts are used for gear; Girls may not play on or in the carts.
- Speed limits at camp are being honored.
- Car(s) at site are backed in and have proper identification as designated emergency vehicle.
- Campers always have a buddy.
- Respect other campers and quiet camp hours
- Follow the check-out procedures
- Leave a clean unit upon check out

SU Campouts Guidelines

- Troops/Groups participating in a Service Unit campout are also eligible, but the Service Unit as a group would not be. Troops that are sharing a site, should work together to achieve their score of 100%.
- Troops must have 5 individuals to be eligible for the courteous camper drawing
- If a complaints or issues arise during a SU campout and we are unable to determine the troop, then the whole service unit will be removed from consideration.

Time Periods & Drawings

- October 1 – Dec 31, with Drawing in January
- January 1 – March 31, Drawing in April
- April 1 – June 30, Drawing July
- July 1 – Sept 30, Drawing in October
