There are lots of ways to volunteer with the troop. Check your choice below. Put a #1 next to your first choice.

Troop Leader (Primary): Organize, plan and lead meetings, activities, and oversee the overall function of the troop. You'll get lots of training online and in-person, including the Volunteer Toolkit to help you along the way with planning, badges, Journeys, communicating with families, and record-keeping.

Troop Program Guide (Primary): Develop fun and educational troop activities based on which Girl Scout Journeys and badges the girls want to complete. Introduce them to new experiences, community service projects, and council-sponsored programs and camping.

Troop Admin (Primary): Manage the troop's paperwork, permission slips, registrations, and roster. Receive troop mail from council and share Girl Scout news and opportunities with families.

Troop Helping Hands: Provide the leaders with extra support and supervision. Chaperone events or field trips, bring snacks, help with crafts and activities, or other duties as needed to help troop meetings run smoothly.

Troop Treasurer: Manage the troop's budget, funds, and bank account. Help girls take the lead in goal setting, decision making, and money management, so they can learn to spend troop funds responsibly.

Field Trip Driver: Provide safe, reliable transportation for the troop trips and activities outside their meeting location. It doesn't hurt to learn a few Girl Scout songs for the ride!

Troop Product Sale Manager/Magazine & Snack Program: Coordinate and assist girls and families with this fall sale. You'll participate in training, manage the sales materials, order placement, product inventory, and girl rewards. (September – January)

Troop Product Sale Manager/Cookie Program: Coordinate and assist girls and their families with the Girl Scout Cookie sale. You'll participate in training, manage the troop's sales materials, order placement, product inventory, schedule booth locations, and girl rewards. (December – May)
